Travel

(1) By air: flight into London Stansted – train to Cambridge Central

There are regular direct services between London Stansted and Cambridge Central (<https://www.greateranglia.co.uk/train-times/stansted-airport-to-cambridge>).

(2) Eurostar into London St Pancras – walk across the road to London King's Cross – train into Cambridge Central

The Eurostar gets into London St Pancras. Next door, literally just across the road, is London King's Cross. From King's Cross, there are regular trains into Cambridge (www.nationalrail.co.uk). Note that many trains stop at Cambridge on the way to another destination (e.g. Kings Lynn), such that it is worth checking on the boards whether Cambridge is one of the stops.

Accommodation

Cambridge is going to be busy in March, but term will be over, nonetheless, please plan ahead!

(1) University rooms (https://www.universityrooms.com/en-GB/city/oxford/home?gclid=CjwKCAiAl9efBhAkEiwA4TorivBvQcUQm14WXXIVjpVM9eMrN8LnY_vQMpoVUNwq2FXyR5U2w44g8RoCaeoQAvD_BwE) – this is a way to book a college room, which is usually both scenic and economical.

(2) If you prefer a hotel, please bear in mind that Churchill College is not located in the city centre and that you may either have to go for a scenic walk in the morning or take a local bus (see also <https://www.chu.cam.ac.uk/about/contact/churchill-college-map/transport-links/>).
